ARIZONA - On Monday, March 3rd, we the United Campus Workers of Arizona (UCWAZ), CWA Local 7065, are proudly partnering with Arizona Student Association (ASA) and Higher Education Labor United (HELU) for a press conference from 8:30 to 9am in the Wesley Bolin Memorial Plaza at the Arizona State Capitol building to kick off our first annual Higher Education Legislative Advocacy (HELA) Day. We will have representatives available to speak to the press during and after the press conference. Featured speakers include:

- Students and staff of the Arizona Students' Association (ASA)
- Higher Education Labor United (HELU)

Higher Education Legislative Advocacy (HELA) Day 2025 is a multi-day event around our union's political advocacy efforts. This year, we are taking our membership to the offices of legislators in Arizona's capitol to push for pro-union and pro-worker relationships and policies.

Our union members have voted to identify our legislative priorities to inform our advocacy work at the Arizona Capitol. HELA Day marks the **beginning** of our collective efforts there to influence policy and change the law to support higher education workers and interests. Our legislative priorities include:

- Increase public state funding for universities
- Respect 1st amendment right to free speech on public university campuses
- Protect academic freedom at our public university campuses
- Support student representation across the state in rural, urban, and underserved communities
- Support K-12 public education and funding
- Protect voting rights and make voting registration more accessible
- Raise workers wages and benefits and lower the cost of living
- Collective bargaining of public employees at universities
- Graduate student fees elimination/bundling

We will bring these issues to our legislators in meetings and Capitol walkthroughs all day on Monday, March 3rd. Together, we can change the law!
